1) COME (Venga)

Come to Me - Matthew 11:28 Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

Come Out From - 2 Corinthians 6:14 Don't team up with those who are unbelievers. How can righteousness be a partner with wickedness? How can light live with darkness? 15 What harmony can there be between Christ and the devil? How can a believer be a partner with an unbeliever? 16 And what union can there be between God's temple and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God said: "I will live in them and walk among them. I will be their God, and they will be my people. 17 Therefore, come out from among unbelievers, and separate yourselves from them, says the Lord. Don't touch their filthy things, and I will welcome you. 18 And I will be your Father, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."

Isaiah 55:1 "Is anyone thirsty? **Come** and drink—even if you have no money! 2 Why spend your money on food that does not give you strength? Why pay for food that does you no good? Listen to me, and you will eat what is good. You will enjoy the finest food. 3 "**Come to me** with your ears wide open. Listen, and you will find life/live forever. I will make an everlasting covenant with you. I will give you all the unfailing love I promised to David."

Jesus calls us FROM that which doesn't stay satisfying to that which will satisfy forever.

Come Forth - John 11: 43 Then Jesus shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" 44 And the dead man came out, his hands and feet bound in graveclothes, his face wrapped in a headcloth. Jesus told them, "Unwrap him and let him go!"

Come to Me/Follow Me - John 7:37 On the last day, the climax of the festival, Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, "Anyone who is thirsty may come to me! 38 Anyone who believes in me may come and drink!"

Matthew 16: **24** Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

BECOME like me! - Matthew 4:18 One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers—Simon, also called Peter, and Andrew—throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living. 19 Jesus called out to them, "Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" 20 And they left their nets at once and followed him.

John 6:37 "Everyone whom the Father gives me will come to me, and the one who **comes** to me I will never send away."

John 6:44 - No man can **come** to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

Come away - Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, "Come." Let anyone who hears this say, "Come." Let anyone who is thirsty come. Let anyone who desires drink freely from the water of life.

We are called....It's up to us to come - John 5:39 You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that testify about me, 40 yet you refuse to come to me to have life.....

Why he calls us - Romans 8:28 And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called (*GR kletos - called, named, summoned*) according to his purpose for them. 29 For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. 30 And having chosen them, he called them to come to him. And having called them, he gave them right standing with himself. And having given them right standing, he gave them his glory.

2) GO (Vamos)

John 15:16 You didn't choose me. I chose you. I appointed/called you to **go** and produce lasting fruit, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for, using my name.

He said to them, "**Go** into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation."
Mark 16:15

Matthew 28:19 Therefore, **go** and **make disciples** of all the nations/PEOPLE, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. 20 **Teach** these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Exodus 4:12 (To Moses) Now **go**! I will be with you as you speak, and I will instruct you in what to say."

Mark 10:52 "**Go**," said Jesus, "your faith has healed you." Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus along the road.

Jesus always sent them after He called them:

Luke 10:3 Now **go**, and remember that I am sending you out as lambs among wolves.

Luke 10:37 The man replied, "The one who showed him mercy." Then Jesus said, "Yes, now **go** and do the same."

Jesus tells His servants to GO so that they can bid others to COME:

Luke 14: 21 The master was furious and said, '**Go** quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and invite the poor, the crippled, the blind, and the lame.' 22 After the servant had done this, he reported, 'There is still room for more.' 23 So his master said, '**Go** out into the country lanes and behind the hedges and urge anyone you find to come, so that the house will be full.
