Saving Grace Is:

G - God's Gift To Me

Romans 5:15 And what a difference between our sin and God's generous gift of forgiveness. For this one man, Adam, brought death to many through his sin. But this other man, Jesus Christ, brought forgiveness to many through God's bountiful gift.

- 16 And the result of God's gracious gift is very different from the result of that one man's sin. For Adam's sin led to condemnation, but we have the free gift of being accepted by God, even though we are guilty of many sins.
- 17 The sin of this one man, Adam, caused death to rule over us, but all who receive God's wonderful, gracious gift of righteousness will live in triumph over sin and death through this one man, Jesus Christ.

R - Received By Faith

Ephesians 2:8 God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God.

Romans 4:16 So that's why faith is the key! God's promise is given to us as a free gift. And we are certain to receive it, whether or not we follow Jewish customs, if we have faith like Abraham's. For Abraham is the father of all who believe.

- 20 Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God.
- 21 He was absolutely convinced that God was able to do anything he promised.
- 22 And because of Abraham's faith, God declared him to be righteous.
- 23 Now this wonderful truth that God declared him to be righteous wasn't just for Abraham's benefit.
- 24 It was for us, too, assuring us that God will also declare us to be righteous if we believe in God, who brought Jesus our Lord back from the dead.
- 25 He was handed over to die because of our sins, and he was raised from the dead to make us right with God.

A - Available To Everyone

Romans 4:16 So that's why faith is the key! God's promise is given to us as a free gift. And we are certain to receive it, whether or not we follow Jewish customs, if we have faith like Abraham's. For Abraham is the father of all who believe.

C - Christ Centered

E - Extended Throughout Eternity

Romans 6:20 In those days, when you were slaves of sin, you weren't concerned with doing what was right.

- 21 And what was the result? It was not good, since now you are ashamed of the things you used to do, things that end in eternal doom.
- 22 But now you are free from the power of sin and have become slaves of God. Now you do those things that lead to holiness and result in eternal life.
- 23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.
