	John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. 17 God did not send his Son into the world to condemn it, but to save it.

- 1 Peter 1:18 For you know that God paid a ransom to save you from the empty life you inherited from your ancestors. And the ransom he paid was not mere gold or silver.
- 19 He paid for you with the precious lifeblood of Christ, the sinless, spotless Lamb of God.
- 20 God chose him for this purpose long before the world began, but now in these final days, he was sent to the earth for all to see. And he did this for you.
- 21 Through Christ you have come to trust in God. And because God raised Christ from the dead and gave him great glory, your faith and hope can be placed confidently in God.

John 16:33 I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world."

Provides	Hope	For	Eternal	Life

- 1 Corinthians 15:16 If there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised.
- 17 And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless, and you are still under condemnation for your sins.
- 18 In that case, all who have died believing in Christ have perished!
- 19 And if we have hope in Christ only for this life, we are the most miserable people in the world.
- 20 But the fact is that Christ has been raised from the dead. He has become the first of a great harvest of those who will be raised to life again.
- 21 So you see, just as death came into the world through a man, Adam, now the resurrection from the dead has begun through another man, Christ.
- 22 Everyone dies because all of us are related to Adam, the first man. But all who are related to Christ, the other man, will be given new life.
- 50 What I am saying, dear brothers and sisters, is that flesh and blood cannot inherit the Kingdom of God. These perishable bodies of ours are not able to live forever.
- 51 But let me tell you a wonderful secret God has revealed to us. Not all of us will die, but we will all be transformed.
- 54 When this happens when our perishable earthly bodies have been transformed into heavenly bodies that will never die then at last the Scriptures will come true: "Death is swallowed up in victory.
- 55 O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?"
- 56 For sin is the sting that results in death, and the law gives sin its power.

57 How we thank God, who gives us victory over sin and death through Jesus Christ our Lord!

58 So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and steady, always enthusiastic about the Lord's work, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever useless.
