THE MESSAGE OF THE CROSS

- 1 Corinthians 1:18 The message of the cross is foolish to those who are headed for destruction! But we who are being saved know it is the very power of God.
- 19 As the Scriptures say, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise and discard the intelligence of the intelligent."
- 20 So where does this leave the philosophers, the scholars, and the world's brilliant debaters? God has made the wisdom of this world look foolish.
- 21 Since God in his wisdom saw to it that the world would never know him through human wisdom, he has used our foolish preaching to save those who believe.
- 22 It is foolish to the Jews, who ask for signs from heaven. And it is foolish to the Greeks, who seek human wisdom.
- 23 So when we preach that Christ was crucified, the Jews are offended and the Gentiles say it's all nonsense.
- 24 But to those called by God to salvation, both Jews and Gentiles, Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of God.

Because It Is Foolish

25 This foolish plan of God is wiser than the wisest of human plans, and God's weakness is stronger than the greatest of human strength.

Romans 11:33 Oh, how great are God's riches and wisdom and knowledge! How impossible it is for us to understand his decisions and his ways!

- 34 For who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enough to give him advice?
- 35 And who has given him so much that he needs to pay it back?
- 36 For everything comes from him and exists by his power and is intended for his glory. All glory to him forever! Amen.
- 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I decided that while I was with you I would forget everything except Jesus Christ, the one who was crucified.
- 3 I came to you in weakness—timid and trembling.
- 4 And my message and my preaching were very plain. Rather than using clever and persuasive speeches, I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit.
- 5 I did this so you would trust not in human wisdom but in the power of God.

Galatians 3:9 So all who put their faith in Christ share the same blessing Abraham received because of his faith.

- 10 But those who depend on the law to make them right with God are under his curse, for the Scriptures say, "Cursed is everyone who does not observe and obey all the commands that are written in God's Book of the Law."
- 11 So it is clear that no one can be made right with God by trying to keep the law. For the Scriptures say, "It is through faith that a righteous person has life."
- 12 This way of faith is very different from the way of law, which says, "It is through obeying the law that a person has life."
- 13 But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
- 14 Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith.

Hebrews 9:27 And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment,
