2 Corinthians 11:2 For I am jealous for you with the jealousy of God himself. I promised you as a pure bride to one husband—Christ. 3 But I fear that somehow your pure and undivided devotion to Christ will be corrupted/destroyed/ruined, just as Eve was deceived by the cunning ways of the serpent.

The Path of Disaffection with God

Ambush

* Some are from Satan

1 Peter 5:8 Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.

* Some are from our broken world

James 1: Dear brothers and sisters, **when** troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow.

Ambush often results in one or more:

Anxiety: Fear plus Anxiety equals Doubt

Doubt leads to disappointment and discouragement

Disappointment and discouragement lead to:

Anger

Aloneness

Alienation / Insulation

Alienation/Insulation leads to arrogance

All of these lead to DISAFFECTION and Disaffection leads to: Adulteries of the Heart

James 1:6Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. 7 Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. 8 Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do.

Recovery of the Disaffected Heart

- 1) Begins With Receiving by Faith The Love, Attention, and Provision of God BY FAITH
- 2) Assess Ourselves

Psalm 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. 24 Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life.

2 Corinthians 7:11 Just see what this godly sorrow produced in you! Such earnestness, such concern to clear yourselves, such indignation, such alarm, such longing to see me, such zeal, and such a readiness to punish wrong. You showed that you have done everything necessary to make things right.

a) Change the way yo	ou think about God:	

Psalm 3:5 I lay down and slept, yet I woke up in safety, for the Lord was watching over me.

Deuteronomy 31:6 So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. **He will neither fail you nor abandon you.**"

- b) *Pursue* Intimacy with God Revelation 2:5....Turn back to me and do the works you did at first.
- c) Be reconciled to God John 15: 4 Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me. 5 "Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For *apart* from me **you can do nothing.**

Hebrews 10:

³² Think back on those early days when you first learned about Christ. Remember how you remained faithful even though it meant terrible suffering. ³³ Sometimes you were exposed to public ridicule and were beaten, and sometimes you helped others who were suffering the same things. ³⁴ You suffered along with those who were thrown into jail, and even when all you owned was taken from you, you accepted it with joy. **You knew there were better things waiting for you that will last forever.**

³⁵ So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings you! ³⁶ Patient endurance is what you need now, so that you will continue to do God's will. Then you will receive all that he has promised.

³⁷ "For in just a little while, the Coming One will come and not delay. ³⁸ And my righteous ones will live by faith. But I will take no pleasure in anyone who turns away."³⁹ But we are not like those who turn away from God to their own destruction. We are the faithful ones, whose souls will be saved.

d) Draw Close to God Through:

1) Action / Spiritual Disciplines

Philippians 4:9 Keep putting into practice all you learned and received from me—everything you heard from me and saw me doing. Then the God of peace will be with you.

2) Accessibility and Accountability

James 5:16 Confess your sins/faults to each other **and** pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.

Hebrews 10:25 And let us not **neglect** our **meeting togethe**r, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

Hebrews 3:13 You must warn each other every day, while it is still "today," so that none of you will be deceived by sin and hardened against God.

Regular fellowship with believers is an essential ingredient in Christian growth.
